GENERAL OVERVIEW

- Mission established on 15 April 2014 and launched on 15 January 2015.
- Budget by mandate: M1 – €5.5m, M2 – €11.4m, M3 – €19.7m, M4 – €19.8m, M5 – €28.4m, M6 – €69.6m, M7 – €86m, M8 – €64.3m, M9 – €59.2m.
- 10-years total budget: 304.9M€

TRAINING¹

- More than 16,000 trainees, including 2,000 women
- More than 1,000 training courses delivered, for a total of more than 8,000 days of training
- Main beneficiaries: National Police (40%), National Gendarmerie (29%), National Guard (17%), other specialised services (DGPTS – 4%, OCS – 4%)
- Most taught themes: Human Rights/Gender/Ethics (+5,000 trainees), Interaction with the Population (+1,000 trainees), Criminal Investigation (+1,000 trainees), Border Management (+1,000 trainees), Human Resources Management (+1,000 trainees), Criminal Investigation (+1,000 trainees)

- €38.3M allocated to projects until January 2025
- Kourémalé Integrated border management centre (2023 – 2025, €5 millions)
- *Maison Justice* in Mopti (2023 – 2025, €1.3 million)
- Bamako/Ségou/Koulikoro/Sikasso radio transmission network (2021 – 2025, in two phases, €4.1 million)
- Listening centre for GBV victims in 4 police stations (2022 – 2023, €0.4 million)
- Construction of a mixed dormitory at the Faladié Gendarmerie School (2021 – 2022, €0.8 million)
- Bénéna Border Police Station (2021 – 2022, €0.6 million)
- FARGEND Gendarmerie camp in Sévaré (2020 – 2021, €1.3 million)
- Building renovation and creation of a command room at the Regional Directorate of the Bamako Police (2017 – 2018, €0.1 million)
- Modernisation of the ISFs' archiving systems (2016 – 2017, €0.18 million)
