The European Union Partnership Mission in the Republic of Moldova (EUPM MOLDOVA) is a non-executive, civilian Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP) Mission, based in Chisinau.

MISSION MANDATE

EUPM Moldova provides the authorities of the Republic of Moldova with strategic advice and operational support to strengthen its internal security sector in the areas of:



Crisis management



Hybrid threats, including cybersecurity and Foreign Information Manipulation and Interference (FIMI)

MISSION ACTIVITIES

EUPM Moldova advises on the development of strategies and policies, and provides trainings and needed equipment. It also assists the Moldovan institutions in developing efficient and sustainable crisis management structures.

The Mission's main partners in the Republic of Moldova are the President's Office, the Prime Minister's Office, the Ministry of Internal Affairs and the Ministry of Economy and Digitalisation.

The Mission has a project cell to support the implementation of activities by offering targeted operational support.



Overall coordination: The Mission is part of the EU's broader support to the Republic of Moldova and works in close coordination with the EU Delegation in Chisinau and EU Member States. Specific activities are identified and implemented in close coordination and together with relevant authorities of the Republic of Moldova.
