Erasmus Mundus Programme

The Erasmus Mundus Programme is a flagship educational initiative of the European Union, unique in its design and implementation. It allows students to pursue a joint master's degree by studying at two or more universities in different countries, within Europe and beyond.

Erasmus Mundus is a specific part of Erasmus+, the EU's overarching programme supporting education, training, youth, and sports.

While Erasmus+ includes many other opportunities, Erasmus Mundus focuses specifically on joint master's programmes offered by university partnerships.

Graduates with an Erasmus Mundus degree earn a globally recognised qualification while studying in a multicultural learning environment.

Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters (EMJMs) are high-level integrated study programmes at master level. The programmes are designed and delivered by an international partnership of higher education institutions from different countries worldwide.

The partnership may also involve other educational and/or non-educational partners with specific expertise and interest in the area of study.

The EU provides funding for these programmes and for competitive scholarships, which the programmes offer to the best student applicants worldwide.

Application Period

Most consortia require applications to be submitted between October and January for courses starting the following academic year.

Each master's website has all the details about the course of study, the list of the participating universities, the entry requirements and all the steps of the application process.

Interested students should visit the master website and directly contact the consortium for information on courses, application procedures and scholarships availability.

Why apply?

Being an Erasmus Mundus scholar comes with a multitude of benefits:

1. **Academic Excellence:** Access to high-quality education and the opportunity to study at several universities in Europe and beyond.
2. **Cultural Exposure:** The chance to experience diverse cultures, languages, and academic systems while studying in different countries.
3. **Professional Development:** Opportunities for research, academic success, and even teaching at European universities.
4. **Networking:** Connect with a wide range of students and professionals from around the world.
5. **Financial Support:** Full scholarships are available for the best-ranked students worldwide, covering participation costs, travel, visa, and living allowances.

Type of degree awarded

You will gain either

- a joint degree (i.e. one single degree certificate issued on behalf of at least two higher education institutions) or
- multiple degrees (i.e. at least two-degree certificates issued by two higher education institutions of the consortium).

You will be able to define these in detail when you sign a study agreement with the relevant Erasmus Mundus Joint Master at the beginning of your studies.



When to apply

A new batch of selected Erasmus Mundus Masters is added to the list each year.

In most cases, you should submit your application between **October** and **January** for courses starting the following academic year.

What you need

You must

- have a bachelor's degree (first degree), or be in your last year of bachelor studies
- graduate before the master's programme starts

You may also apply if you demonstrate a bachelor's equivalent level of learning. This must be officially recognised, according to national legislation and practices, in the degree awarding country.

Important tips

1. Thoroughly research the listed programmes to find the one(s) that best fits your academic and career aspirations.
2. Check the specific requirements and start preparing the required documents. Each programme may have unique document requirements.
3. Reach out to Erasmus Mundus students or alumni, programme coordinators, or your academic advisors for guidance and support.
4. Aim to submit your application well before the deadline to avoid last-minute issues.
5. Ensure all documents are complete and accurate before submission.
6. Apply through the provided application portal.
7. Follow-up by checking your email regularly for any updates or additional requests from the programme coordinators.
