Annex 2 - List of Recommended Security Equipment

<p>European Union Integrated Border Management Assistance Mission in Libya (EUBAM Libya) 1-2026 Call for Contributions</p>

Seconded experts deployed to EUBAM Libya should have the following clothing and equipment:

- a) Clothes must be adapted to the climate which is dry with a great fluctuation of temperature;
- b) It is advisable to have clothing for official meetings and field trips; (Suit and office attire and for the field comfortable attire);
- c) Shoes must be adapted to the climate and for official visits;
- d) Flashlight (spare batteries);
- e) Sun glasses;
- f) Non-alcoholic antibacterial hand wash;
- g) Mosquito repellent;
- h) Eye wash solution;
- i) Rehydration packs;
- j) 30 liters waterproof backpack is recommended;
- k) Personal medication with prescriptions for minimum of eight (8) weeks.

All EUBAM Libya mission members are required to be equipped with the following personal protective equipment:

- Ballistic helmet: NIJ IIIA;
- Tactical vest: Hard plates: NIJ IV.

All EUBAM Libya seconded mission members are recommended to bring the following equipment (in line with job requirements) with supporting Seconding authority letter:

- Ballistic helmet: NIJ IIIA (low profile (low profile APO and APO Coordinator));
- Tactical vest: Hard plates: NIJ IV (Stand-alone low-profile APO and APO Coordinator);
- Plate carrier (Stand alone low profile APO and APO Coordinator).
