Important!

If selected under contracted status, you will be requested to supply documentary evidence which supports the statements you made above. Do not, however, send any documentary evidence until you have been asked to do so.

Please note that recruitment of couples and family members in CSDP Missions/Office is possible, provided that they will act independently in their area of work, i.e. they do not work in a direct hierarchical relationship; do not work in the same unit; do not have close professional relationship/significant impact on each other's area of work.

With reference to the Call for Contributions, please be reminded that physical and mental health are general conditions and considered as essential requirement of the selection to all positions of civilian CSDP Missions. Candidates must be physically fit and in good health without any physical or mental problems or substance dependency which may impair operational performance in the Area of Operations of the Mission. If you are selected, before receiving the final job/internship offer, you will be required to certify being medically fit for the specific post. This entails complying with medical procedure requested by the seconding authority or the civilian CSDP Missions' medical procedure ("Fit to work clearance" procedure) that includes health check and might include, for certain security and/or armed positions, a mandatory psychological assessment and drug screening. In a similar manner a dental examination should be certified where it is stated that no eminent dental issues are foreseen. As temporary measure and while the COVID-19 pandemic persists, the Mission will take into account the exceptional circumstances of COVID-19 crisis*. Only selected candidate proven to be medically fit to work in the Area of Operations of the Mission will receive a final job offer. For selected contracted candidates, in compliance with "Fit to work clearance procedure", a copy of the result of the medical examinations as well as the fitness to work certificate, for seconded selected candidate, the fitness to work certificate must be sent to the Medical Adviser of the Mission before joining the Mission. Medical data will be handled with confidentiality and in line with EU Charter of Fundamental Rights and the Standard Operating Procedure on the protection of personal data (CivOpsCdr instruction 12-2018 as amended.)

The Heads of Mission reserve the right to reject the recruitment/deployment of any selected candidates who proves to be medically unfit to work in a civilian CSDP Mission.

To ensure duty of care in the CSDP Missions, selected seconded/contracted candidates shall be able to serve the full period of secondment/contract before reaching the normal age of retirement in Contributing (Third) States/country of residence.

En ce qui concerne l'appel à contributions, nous vous rappelons que la santé physique et mentale est une condition générale qui est considérée comme un critère essentiel de la sélection pour tous les postes des missions civiles PSDC. Les candidats doivent être physiquement aptes et en bonne santé, sans aucun problème physique ou mental ni dépendance aux substances qui pourrait nuire à la performance opérationnelle dans la zone d'opérations de la mission. Si vous êtes sélectionné, avant de recevoir l'offre finale d'emploi / de stage, vous devrez certifier que vous êtes médicalement apte à occuper le poste en question. Cela implique de se conformer à la procédure médicale demandée par l'autorité de détachement ou à la procédure médicale des missions civiles PSDC (procédure d'habilitation d'aptitude au travail ou « Fit to work clearance ») qui comprend un examen de santé et peut inclure, pour certains postes de sécurité et / ou armés, une évaluation psychologique obligatoire et un test pour le dépistage de drogues. De la même manière, un examen dentaire doit être fourni et accompagné par un certificat indiquant qu'aucun problème dentaire significatif n'est prévu. À titre de mesure temporaire et tant que la pandémie du COVID-19 persiste, la Mission tiendra compte des circonstances exceptionnelles de cette crise*. Seul les candidats sélectionnés dont il est prouvé qu'ils sont médicalement aptes à travailler dans la zone d'opérations de la Mission recevront une offre d'emploi finale. Pour les candidats sélectionnés sous contrat, conformément à la «Procédure d'autorisation d'aptitude au travail», une copie des résultats des examens médicaux ainsi que le certificat d'aptitude au travail,
