

# SUPPORT TO TRI-PARTITE COOPERATION ON CRISES ASSESSMENTS (RPBA, PDNA, PRNA)

MAY 2026

## CONTEXT

Since 2008, the European Union, the United Nations and the World Bank have worked together to assist countries recovering from conflict-related or natural crises. They provide support in understanding the root causes of crises, assessing the level of damages and losses, and defining recovery activities to address the resulting needs. In 2026, the tripartite partners launched a new Operational Approach on Post-Crisis Assessments and Recovery Planning, to strengthen cooperation and adapt to contemporary crisis contexts.

The support to tripartite cooperation is available to the EU Delegations willing to mobilize expertise in order to support national authorities in these processes.

## OVERALL OBJECTIVE

The overall objective is to support third countries to carry out Recovery and Peacebuilding Assessments (RPBA)/ Post-Disaster Needs Assessment (PDNA)/ Post-Conflict Needs Assessment (PRNA), through provision of technical expertise.

## SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- 1) To assist, together with the United Nations and the World Bank, countries affected by crisis with identifying, developing, and implementing recovery activities through RPBA/PDNA/PRNA processes.
- 2) To support further development of the joint RPBA/PDNA/PRNA methodologies, tools, and training programmes.
- 3) To promote the values and principles of the EU as a global actor.
- 4) To ensure inclusiveness of RPBA/PDNA/PRNA processes.

## EXPECTED RESULTS

Continue supporting RPBA/PDNA/PRNA missions (crisis assessments), trainings, and events.

## ACTIVITIES

- Deployment of experts in RPBA/PDNA/PRNA missions (crisis assessments).
- Provision of training and capacity building activities to national authorities and regional/international organisations.
- Reporting on RPBA/PDNA/PRNA activities.
- Coordination between EU services and within the tri-partite group.
- Updating, revising, and further developing the joint methodologies and tools.
- Providing sector analysis and support to the long-term technical assistance.
