# Let's MEETup 27

Myanmar–EU EmpowermentT (MEETup) is the flagship youth initiative funded by the European Union (EU) and implemented by the EU Delegation in Myanmar, in collaboration with EU Member State Embassies and partner organisations.

Launched in 2024, the programme has built a growing network of youth alumni who continue to inspire, lead, and collaborate—translating their MEETup experience into real-world impact as community ambassadors for the EU.

Now entering its third edition, MEETup 2027 will bring together a new cohort of young people from across the country to connect, learn, and engage with EU and its partners through interactive sessions and creative exchange. The programme offers a unique opportunity for Myanmar youth to play an active role in strengthening relations between the EU and the people of Myanmar, while deepening their understanding of Europe.



## Who can apply?

The MEETup programme is designed for young people in Myanmar who have the potential to become thoughtful communicators and changemakers — individuals who are curious about Europe, eager to learn, and motivated to make a difference.

## We are looking for applicants who meet the following criteria:



**Aged 16–24**



Motivated to grow both personally and professionally



**Residing in Yangon Region** or able to arrange at own cost for travel to Yangon for in-person activities or **with stable internet access** for remote participation as needed



Have at least **intermediate English skills**



Show interest in **international relations, Europe, and social impact**



Willing to **collaborate, share ideas,** and engage on a range of issues

**The programme runs from Mid–November 2026 to Mid–March 2027, for 4 months. Full participation in programme activities is required (a minimum of 4 hours per month).**

## Your role in MEETup 2027

As a MEETup participant, you'll take an active role in shaping EU–youth engagement in Myanmar. Throughout the programme, you will:

**Participate** in interactive workshops, meetups, and dialogue sessions

**Interact** with EU experts and peers to explore European values, global topics, and youth action

**Collaborate** with fellow youth and EU partners on shared ideas and initiatives

**Co–create** stories, visuals, or creative content that amplify your voice and experience

**Become part of** an active and growing youth network across Myanmar

## How to apply

The application process consists of two stages: [an online application form](#), and an interview for shortlisted candidates.

Mandatory documents required:

1. A copy of passport or identity card
2. Personal CV
3. Expression of motivation & interest

All documents must be uploaded through the online application link. We encourage applicants to submit additional documents that will support their application such as school certificates, diplomas, or letter of recommendation etc. The Selection Committee may request for other supporting documents if necessary.
