

Funded traineeship for young graduates at the EU Delegation to Singapore

Are you a **young graduate** interested in international relations? Are you curious to learn more about work of a diplomatic mission and how the EU Delegation represents EU interests and values in Singapore?

We offer:

A traineeship of up to 6 months for support to the EU Delegation to Singapore, starting in November 2026:

Main tasks:

- Contribute to the reporting on domestic developments in Singapore and in the region (ASEAN and Indo-Pacific) and on Singapore's relations with its foreign partners.
- Support the implementation of – and participate in outreach activities around – the EU's bilateral cooperation agreements with Singapore.
- Conduct research and draft background papers on various policy issues.
- Assist in preparation of visits of senior EU officials to Singapore, meetings, public diplomacy events hosted at and by the Delegation.
- Attend and report on conferences, seminars and lectures covering political, security and other developments in Singapore and in the region.
- Draft minutes of meetings and assist in writing reports.
- Assist in compiling the Delegation's daily press review.
- Assist in the handling of the Delegation's social media, notably on X, Instagram, LinkedIn and Facebook.

We are looking for:

Qualifications or special requirements:

- Knowledge of EU institutions and policies
- Eagerness to learn, motivation to work in a team, attention to details
- Fluency in English
- Competence in the use of social media is an advantage
- Candidates must have less than one year of professional experience after their graduation by the signing of the Traineeship agreement. (other traineeships, student jobs or volunteering works carried out during university or after graduation are not considered as professional experience)

The following would be assets:

- Background in political and social sciences and/or international relations, or a proven capacity in one of those fields
- Knowledge of Singapore and the region (ASEAN countries and the Indo-Pacific)
- General understanding of international trade and economic matters
- Legal or economic background.

Important information to read before applying

Before applying you are requested to examine the [dedicated website](#) as well as the [general eligibility criteria](#) for a paid traineeship (Article 8 of the Decision ADMIN(2017)28 – Paid traineeship).

Each selected trainee will receive a [monthly grant](#) to cover living expenses. All costs related to travels, visa, insurance, accommodation must be borne by the trainee.

Applications from non-eligible candidates will not be considered. After the evaluation of all applications, shortlisted candidates will be contacted and invited for an interview. Unsuccessful candidates will be notified by email. In case the selected candidates are not able to present the required documents, their application will be rejected.

The traineeship can only be offered in compliance with the local legislation as well as the legislation of the country of origin.

Citizens from EU Member states:

- **must provide proof that they will be covered against the risk of a pandemic and the costs of repatriation;**
- **must hold a relevant entrance visa and / or temporary residence permit where applicable, based on the traineeship agreement, the duration of the traineeship, and in compliance with the local legislation.**
