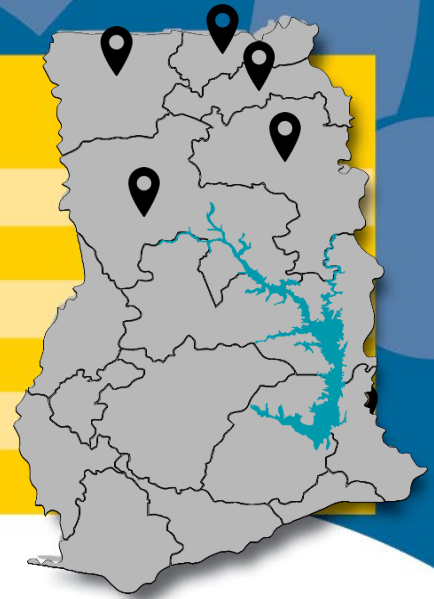

## Background



The NORPREVSEC Programme aims at preventing pre- and post-electoral violence and at countering violent extremism, terrorism and organized crime in five northernmost regions in Ghana. The programme also addresses the root causes of inter-ethnic and communal violence as well as the rise of violent extremism and religious radicalization, predominantly among the youth. The NCCE's role is to sensitize and create awareness among various segments of the population on the threats of violent extremism and terrorism.



## Project Details



**Overall Objective:** To promote good and inclusive governance by contributing directly to resilience and security in Ghana.

**Specific Objective:** To prevent pre- and post-electoral violence, and to better equip key governmental and non-governmental actors in their joint and coordinated efforts to sustain peace and to contain violent extremism.

**Target Group(s):** Staff of the NCCE, traditional authorities, opinion leaders, gunsmiths, students, youth, media practitioners, identifiable groups, civil society organisations, community-based organisations, public servants and the general public.

## Expected Results



- Mechanisms/platforms created to sustain dialogue and engagement to prevent pre- and post-electoral violence;
- NCCE better equipped in coordinated efforts on peace;
- Heightened awareness/sensitization created to contain the rise of violent extremism/vigilantism;
- Risk of political and inter-communal violence reduced;
- Pre- and post-electoral violence reduced;
- Violence against women and children reduced;
- Detection of radicalization processes among the youth.
