### Panel 1 - Approaches for Gender Equality around the World

### H.E. Nadia Theodore

Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Canada to the World Trade Organization



Nadia Theodore (BA Hons and MA [Political Science], Carleton University; LLB, University of London) joined the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade Canada in 2004 as a trade negotiator. During her time as a federal public servant she has held progressively senior roles in economic, international and social policy, including at the Canada Revenue Agency and Public Safety Canada. She served at the permanent mission in Geneva from 2009 to 2012 and as consul general in Atlanta from 2017 to 2020.

Most recently, Ms. Theodore was a senior vice president at Maple Leaf Foods, a Canadian consumer packaged goods company and the first major food company in the world to be carbon neutral.

### H.E. Dr. Sofia Boza

Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Chile to the World Trade Organization

Sofía Boza was appointed by President Gabriel Boric to be the Ambassador of Chile to the World Trade Organization from July 2022. Prior to that, she was an associate professor and chief at the Department of Rural Management and Innovation at the University of Chile and professor at the Institute of International Studies at the same University. She holds a bachelor's degree in Economics (Honors) from the University of Seville, a professional title in Commercial Engineering from the University of Chile, a master's in Economic Development and Public Policies and a PhD in Economics from the Autonomous University of Madrid. She has published more than half a hundred academic publications in the last years on agricultural policy and governance, rural development, food markets and international trade.

Petros Mavromichalis took office as Ambassador of the European Union to Switzerland and the Principality of Liechtenstein on 1 September 2020.
