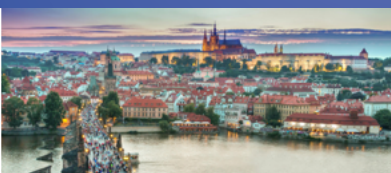

Emerging leaders in the governmental, civil society and business spheres, who are less than 40 years of age and of diverse gender, social, economic, ethnic and geographical backgrounds.
