The **22 European countries** participating in Study in Europe 2022 are: Austria, Belgium, Czechia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Malta, The Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Spain and Sweden.

WEBINARS

The fair, through its digital platform, connects undergraduate and post-graduate students in Singapore and the region with universities from these countries. On 24th September, students and parents will be able to pick from nearly **30 webinars** by the 22 participating countries and explore education opportunities in Europe. Leading up to the series of webinars, the fair's website already presents information on education institutions, the application process and student life. It also highlights the many universities where courses are conducted in English and details of various bond-free scholarships.

ERASMUS+ AND OTHER EU PROGRAMMES

Study In Europe also highlights and helps promote EU education programmes such as Erasmus+, SHARE and EURAXESS.

Erasmus+ enables university students to study or intern in a European country. It offers students a chance to broaden their horizons as they explore European cultures and gain insights into Europe. Erasmus+ funding includes support for education and training of staff, youth workers, and partnerships between universities, colleges, schools, enterprises, and not-for-profit organizations. This year, the EU Delegation to Singapore together with EURAXESS presents the webinar titled *The Erasmus+ Journey*. The webinar will offer insights into the exciting opportunity for an unparalleled experience as a student in Europe. Erasmus+ offers a unique opportunity to study at multiple higher education institutions across Europe. In this session Erasmus Mundus scholars from across ASEAN will share 'their Erasmus journey' and an expert from Brussels will explain how EU's flagship student exchange programme works.

Students can also learn more about **SHARE**, the EU-ASEAN project Supporting Higher Education in ASEAN. Funded by the European Union, SHARE encourages student mobility within the region. The programme has already provided **400 scholarships** for ASEAN students to study in other ASEAN countries, replicating the Erasmus+ intra-EU scholarship scheme. The SHARE programme will open the Study in Europe webinar series with its webinar titled: *Intra-ASEAN Virtual Exchange and Collaborative Online International Learning*.

Continuing the fair's collaboration with **EURAXESS**, a platform for researchers, entrepreneurs, universities and businesses, a webinar titled *How to do a funded PhD in Europe - Doctoral Candidates from ASEAN share their story*, will be presented. Europe has several opportunities for Doctoral training and European PhD programmes enjoy international recognition for excellence providing an exceptional career launch pad for young researchers. At this webinar, post-graduate students will learn how to carry out their doctoral training in Europe and how EURAXESS can support them.
