Short description of the action and its main objectives	The overall objective of the Action is to strengthen the role of the civil society and lawyers' community members to promote and effectively protect human rights under the United Nations human rights system. The Action has three specific objectives: (1) building the capacity of
	national CSOs and lawyers' community members in the international advocacy to promote and protect human rights by use of the UN Human Rights system; (2) promoting the role and increasing the number of national actors in making substantive submissions to the UN Treaty Bodies; and (3) promoting and increasing the use of national human rights protection systems for national actors, specifically for vulnerable groups.

Expected results / Results achieved	 Built capacity of 117 members of the national CSOs and lawyers' community members in international advocacy to promote and protect human rights by use of the UN Human Rights system; Free and professional legal services available for the benefit of the vulnerable groups in the Resource Centre; Free space and facilities at the Resource Centre for the benefit of the CSOs and lawyers' community members; 355 individuals in Baku and in the regions benefited from free legal services on a broad range of social and economic rights; 174 participants benefited from outreach activities delivered by national CSOs with the support and facilitation of the Resource Centre. 7 compilations of guides on UN Human Rights mechanisms made available in Azerbaijani.
