OVERVIEW

French frigate Commandant Ducuing is an 80 meters length Frigate, the 15th from a series of 17 warships. She has been admitted to service in 1983. She is capable of leading all kinds of naval operations at sea, on her own but also inside a Task group. Built on a robust design, she has a reliable propulsion system which allows her to be used for overseas presence missions.

Among the most frequent missions she is assigned to:

- Deterrence operations inside crisis area (embargo control, counter-terrorism)
- Maritime operations (surveillance and defense of maritime approaches against emergent threat such as illegal activities, terrorism, maritime pollution, etc.).

The frigate is heavily armed with a 100mm caliber, two 20mm guns as well as four 12,7mm calibers. Onboard, 102 crewmembers are taking part to EUNAVFOR MED Sophia operations.
