

Program Development Objective

The European Union is providing support to the City of Kyzyl Kiya to rehabilitate water supply services and selected wastewater improvements in the City. Investments are expected to significantly improve infrastructure in the water system, reduce water losses, and optimise operating costs for the Kyzyl Kiya Water Company.



A total of 6 million euros were invested to address the infrastructure and rehabilitation needs in the water sector in Kyzyl Kiya.

Beneficiaries

45,882 people are currently serviced by the water companies in Cholpon Ata; the quality of service is predicted to serve 51,347 people after the project implementation.

Project's activities:

- Improving critical water supply
- Improving resilience to climate change
- Rehabilitating of water networks
- Installation of metering operation

Expected outcomes

- The number of people with access to affordable, drinking tap water will increase from 5,896 to 36,800;
- ➤ Implementation of an individual metering system for each household and of a metering based billing;
- Reduction of CO2 derived from reduction in water losses at system level.
