### **EU Solidarity with Ukraine**

- **€90 million** (S\$135 million) in humanitarian assistance.
- **€500 million** in defence support. The funding under the European Peace Facility provides equipment and supplies to the Ukrainian armed forces to defend territorial integrity and sovereignty.
- **€1.2 billion** in urgent macro-financial assistance to support Ukraine economically.
